Manuscripts submitted for publication must be up to seven pages in length, including tables, illustrations (if any), and references. References should be formatted according to the **APA Style** rules, and all recoverable resources cited in the text must be included in the reference list. Your manuscript should be in Microsoft Word for Windows (file in DOC- or DOCX format), font Times New Roman, 14 pt, single space, single column with 2.0 cm all margins on the A4 (210×297 mm) paper size. Manuscripts that do not meet the conference scope will be declined and the conference organizing committee will inform the authors about it.
